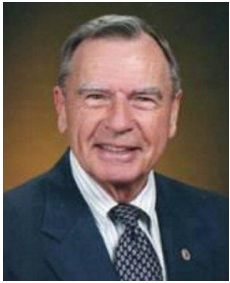


MURRAY THOMAS MILES, JR MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP



Murray Thomas Miles, Jr (1930 – 2017)

Reared in Rutherford County and growing up on a Jersey dairy farm, Murray developed a love for agriculture and all it involved. He was educated at Walter Hill School and Murfreesboro Central High School, being very active in 4-H at all levels. He attended the University of Tennessee and graduated with a degree in agriculture. After serving his country, Murray joined the staff of Tennessee Farm Bureau where he was the Director of Communications producing TV, radio, editorial writing and editor of the organization's newspaper. He was known as "The Voice of Tennessee Agriculture" and worked there for forty years retiring in 1995. He was dedicated to

agriculture's youth and the promotion of Tennessee's farmers.

Application Requirements:

A scholarship of **\$2,500.00** will be awarded to a Rutherford County student majoring in any of the emphasis areas in Agriculture, who is a Rutherford County resident and whose parents/guardians or the applicant is a member of the Rutherford County Farm Bureau. You must apply for admittance, and be accepted for the fall semester to a Tennessee College, University or Trade School to be considered for the scholarship. Upon completion of the fall semester, a second **\$2,500.00** will be awarded if the applicant qualifies with a grade point average of 2.5 or above and is registered as a fulltime student for the Spring Semester.

In addition to this application, we request the following:

1. **A cover letter stating your career plans, and how they align with Murray Miles' life and extensive career.**
2. **Two letters of recommendation in support of your application** to be addressed to the Scholarship Committee. One letter must be from a former high school teacher or college professor. The second letter may be from any other person who knows you well, other than a parent.
3. **ACT score and a transcript of your grades showing GPA and proof of enrollment for Fall semester** to be sent to the Scholarship Committee.
4. **A 2 x 3 size head-and-shoulders color photograph**
5. **This application must be submitted to the Rutherford County Farm Bureau Office at 818 S Church St, Murfreesboro, TN 37128 or post marked by March 15th to be considered. PLEASE DO NOT STAPLE PAPERS TOGETHER**
